

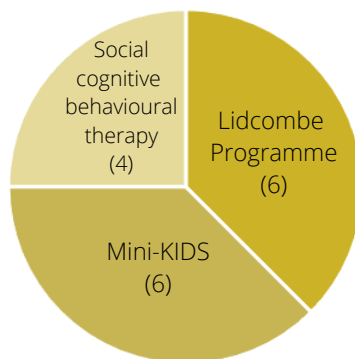
### Numbers

There are currently **27 speech language therapists** participating in our study, 14 Dutch-speaking and 13 French-speaking. Thanks to them, we have already welcomed **35 children** to our study. There is even one speech language therapist who already treats five children in our study.

In the meantime, we continue to look for preschool children who stutter.

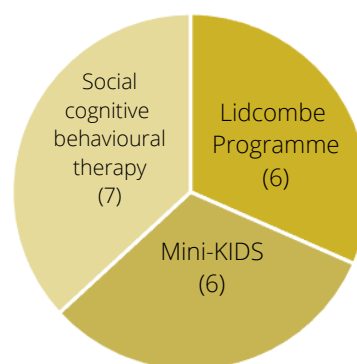
#### Overview Flanders

### Where are we currently in our research?

All speech-language therapists received their training on the three treatments before the start of the study. We are now in the process of **collecting children who stutter**. The children within the study have already started their treatment.



#### **Great news: the first child in the maintenance phase!**

This phase starts when the goals within the assigned treatment program have been achieved. Usually there is (almost) no more stuttering. The speech-language therapist continues to monitor the child for a while to make sure that there is no relapse of stuttering.
